Division Prizes: 1st thru 3rd place monetary prizes for Levels 3 & 4.

Paul Perry Award for the best Showcase Concert performance

Rotary Prize: open to an instrumental student in 9th through 12th grade who lives in and attends school in Western Nevada County (excluding the Truckee area). **Rotary winner must be available to compete Live at the Rotary RALLYE Competition on Saturday, April 29, 2023 in Stateline Nevada.**

Finalist Showcase: Finalists will be announced the third Week in February and our Showcase concert will be Sunday, February 26, 2023.

Fee: \$15 for Division 1 and 2 per entry

\$25 for Division 3 and 4 and Ensemble (includes Rotary Competition) per entry

MUSIC IN THE MOUNTAINS YOUNG MUSICIANS COMPETITION

The Young Musicians Competition (YMC) was first held in 1987. This competition provides the opportunity for instrumental music students, grades 3-12 to study, and perform classical, Broadway, jazz or other repertoire for professional judges. Participating students will each receive detailed written critiques from the adjudicators.

The Rotary Clubs of Western Nevada Country have been holding a music competition for the past 16 years. The winner of this additional award, as determined by our judges, must be a high school student (grades 9 – 12) who resides and attends school in Nevada County (excluding the Truckee area). This year's winner will participate as the entry from Western Nevada County in the Rotary District Music Contest Competition on Saturday, April 29, 2023. The 3 District prizes are \$500, \$750, and \$1,000 (*winner must be available to go to Stateline, Nevada for the competition).
